Enjoy a stroll through *Whisky Jack's Moonshine Still Museum* to see an unmatched collection of prohibition-era moonshine stills, bootlegging relics, and family heirlooms from decades in the wine industry.



2:15 PM - Board the shuttle van and relax for the return to **Springfield** to visit the **History Museum on the Square**.



3:15 PM - Arrive at the *History Museum on the Square*, voted America's No. 1 new attraction by *USA Today*. Located on historic Route 66 in the heart of downtown Springfield, this three-story museum honors Springfield's past, including the Birthplace of Route 66 and the first Wild West shoot-out site. Other galleries include Native Crossroads at the Spring; Trains, Trolleys, and Transportation; Pioneers and Founders at the Crossroads; and Civil War in Springfield. These interactive galleries allow you to drive a trolley, test your wild west skills, wade in a stream with fish, dance to an authentic jukebox, tour Route 66, or take a selfie in the back seat of a '57 Chevy Bel Air convertible at the drive-in! We have an hour to take it all in!
